







Breakdown of Participation by State








Years Engaged with the Groundfish Industry








Percent of Household Income from Fishing








Percent of Household Income from Groundfishing








Boat Size

Environmental Resilience

Fishery stakeholders who exhibit stewardship of resources that is consistent with the long-term health and restoration of the marine ecosystem.





Governance

Participatory, accountable, and decentralized governance structures at various scales that include local involvement in decision-making and maintain an adaptive regulatory environment.

Economic Viability

An economically viable, safe, and sustainable fleet that works with shoreside infrastructure to supply seafood and job opportunities for coastal communities.





Diversity

A geographically distributed commercial and recreational fleet that includes all gear types

MSA National Standards

- Allocation fair and equitable (NS 4)
- Promote efficiency (NS 5)
- Minimize costs (NS 7)
- Minimize impacts to fishing communities (NS 8)
- Minimize bycatch (NS 9)
- Promote Safety (NS 10)



MSA Limited Access Privilege Programs

Section 303A, Part (c)

- LAPP must reduce capacity if overcapacity exists
- LAPP must promote safety and social and economic benefits



MSA Limited Access Privilege Programs

Section 303A, Part (d)(5)

- Promote the sustained participation of small owner-operated fishing vessels and fishing communities
- Address excessive consolidation
- Quota set-asides for entry-level and small vessel owner-operators, captains, crew, and fishing communities
- No excessive shares



FMP Goals/Objectives

Groundfish Amendment 16

- Control capacity to achieve economic efficiency
- Encourage diversity of the fishing fleet
- Minimize adverse impacts on fishing communities and shoreside infrastructure
- Promote stewardship
- Minimize bycatch

Policy Statements

Rebuilding our fisheries is essential to preserving the livelihoods of fishermen, the vibrancy of our coastal communities, a sustainable supply of healthy seafood, and restoring ocean ecosystems to a healthy state. 
